Frequently Asked Questions

Will Dawn-till-Dusk Breakfast and After School Club's be on? Yes, for working parents only – If you haven't already booked your child a place, please call the school and select the Dawn-till-Dusk option to book your child in (after 2nd September 2020).

Will children need to wear masks? No. Government guidance states children do not need to wear masks in school.

Can children take in little hand sanitiser bottles of their own? No. For health and safety reasons, children are not allowed to bring unnecessary items into school. We have lots of hand sanitiser and wipes etc. in school.

How will the bubbles work with 25+ children in one class? Children will remain in their bubbles during lesson, lunch and break times.

How will break times work? Will children be allowed to play outside? Yes. Playtimes will be staggered and classes will have their own play space.

What day does the school reopen? School will reopen Wednesday 2nd September.

What time will school start and finish? In order to minimise the impact of teaching, the school will start and finish at the same time for all children. The bell will ring at 8:55am - the usual time for all children. KS1 children will enter and leave school using the main pupil doors. KS2 children will enter and leave school using the doors at the bottom of the stairs onto the school playground, gates will be unlocked for parents to access. Transport children will enter and leave school using the main visitor entrance.

Do children have to wear school uniform? Yes. Children will be expected to wear full school uniform and they can come to school wearing their PE kit on the days they have PE. No PE kit is to be left at school.

What about reading books? Children will still receive reading books. Returned reading books will be placed in a box for 48hrs quarantine, before they go back on shelves ready for redistribution.

What about homework? Children will still receive homework. Returned homework will be placed in a box for 48hrs, before it is checked by a member of staff and reissued.

Do child need to bring in their own stationary? **No. Children will be provided with stationery in school.**
