HOME LEARNING SUPPORT FOR PARENTS

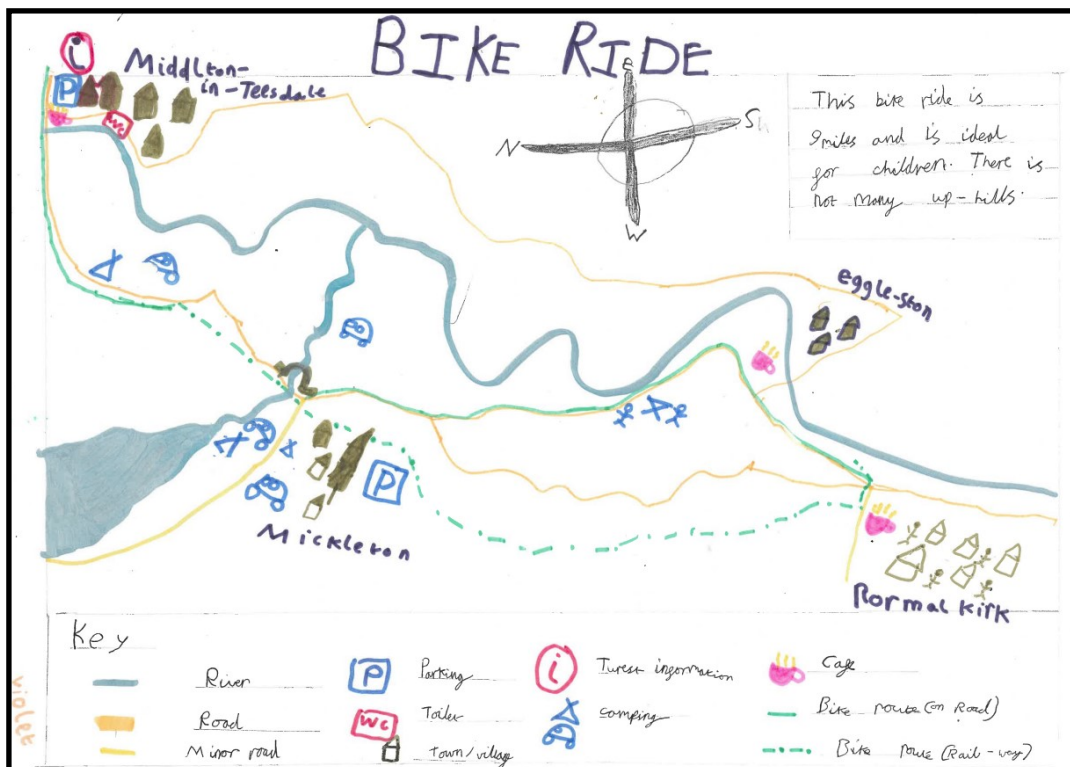
