ALEX DEWAR - INVICTUS 2018

On Thursday 18th March, we had the pleasure of welcoming Mr Alex Dewar to our school to talk to pupils in KS2. Alex was a highly successful Army Warrant Officer with the world at his feet, when he suffered a brain haemorrhage at the age of 34, which would change his life forever.

Our pupils took part in outdoor activities, including an army workout and also had a session of creative writing and through this they were taught all about the resilience, courage and determination that Alex has had to find to rebuild his life following his accident and how physical activity and fitness was key to his survival and recovery. This survival and fitness saw Alex take part in the 2018 Invictus Games representing Team GB.
