

Later in the week, the children started to look at the features of a narrative and amazed us with their knowledge on what they needed to include.

In PSHE, the children have been celebrating differences and exploring how they can resolve conflict, and understanding that people can have different opinions, but it does not need to cause arguments.

#### Y5/6 – Miss Dobinson and Mrs Emery


Last week we oozed with creativity as we designed, built and tested a model Spacecraft as we participated in the Road to RIAT challenge, in partnership with the RAF. Not only did this challenge develop our scientific and engineering skills, but also allowed us to develop teamwork and resilience.

We have also had great success in writing our own non-chronological reports about Earth and Space - every child has really embraced the topic and written their own interesting facts.

In French this week, we have learnt classroom commands and days of the week - try asking your child what day of the week it is to really embed that learning!

This week in geography, we delved deeper into understanding what vegetation belts are, and how there is a notable connection between plant life and climate zones. To consolidate this learning, we created our own fact files which identify the five main types of vegetation.
